

Media Campaign Dues Special Assessment

FAQ

1. When should the 2020 assessment be invoiced to member facilities?

- a. Member facilities should be invoiced as soon as feasible and preferably by the end of July.
- b. Member facilities may be invoiced in conjunction with a regular dues billing or state assessment.

2. When are assessments to be paid to AHCA?

- Assessments received should be remitted to AHCA monthly. Assessments collected during the month should be remitted to AHCA by the 15th day of the following month.
- b. A listing of the amounts being remitted by member (including AHCA ID number) should be submitted with each payment.

3. Will AHCA provide any materials for members to be included in the invoices?

a. Yes. AHCA will provide information about the campaign, an explanation of the assessment and a video of Mark Parkinson explaining the assessment and campaign. All of these can/should be shared with your members.

4. What is the assessment rate?

- a. Member facilities should be assessed at \$10 per bed.
- b. Facilities with over 200 beds should be capped at 200 beds.

5. Which categories of beds are included in the assessment?

- a. Regular SNF beds and Medicaid-only SNF beds are included.
- b. Assisted Living beds are NOT included.
- c. ID/DD beds are NOT included.

6. If a member joins later in the year is the assessment pro-rated?

- a. No, assessments are not prorated.
 - i. All facilities in membership in June 2020 should be assessed for 2020.
 - ii. All facilities in membership in June 2021 should be assessed for 2021.

7. If AHCA is invoicing my members, can they pay by credit card?

a. Yes.

8. Does the discount for annual or modified quarterly dues payors apply to assessment remittances?

a. No.

9. How will delinquent payors be addressed?

- a. If the state affiliate has elected to invoice the members, delinquency should be addressed in the same manner as dues delinquency.
- b. If the state affiliate has elected for AHCA to invoice the members, AHCA will work in conjunction with the affiliate on collection.
- c. Non-payment of the mandatory assessment will be addressed on a caseby-case basis.
