Enrolled COVID-19 Vaccination Provider Partners,

Employers can help in Ohio's COVID-19 vaccination efforts by making it easy for interested employees to get vaccinated by hosting onsite vaccination clinics for them. Employers wishing to host a vaccine clinic, however, do need to partner with an enrolled COVID-19 vaccination provider who is willing to conduct such onsite clinics for them.

In April, the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) surveyed enrolled COVID-19 vaccination providers and created a <u>list of participating providers</u> who are willing to conduct onsite vaccination clinics for interested employers. ODH shared the list with Ohio employers, and encouraged them to contact a participating local provider to schedule COVID-19 vaccination clinics for their interested employees. We want to send employers an updated list of participating providers.

If you have enrolled as a COVID-19 vaccination provider since the previous survey and <u>are</u> willing to conduct vaccination clinics for interested employers in your community, or if you were unable to conduct such clinics for employers at the time of the last survey but are able to do so now, we ask that you provide contact information at this <u>link</u>. <u>Please provide this information by</u> October 1.

ODH has provided guidance and tools for both employers who want to host COVID-19 vaccination clinics for their employees and for participating providers that are available conduct vaccination clinics on the state coronavirus website's <u>COVID-19 Vaccination Program for</u> <u>Businesses and Organizations</u> webpage.
