

Quick Reference Guide: Impact of Vaccination for SNF Residents

Fully vaccinated = 14 days or more after the last shot required (2nd for Pfizer and Moderna, 1st for Janssen).

Close contact = within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period* starting from 2 days before illness onset (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days prior to test specimen collection) until the time the patient is isolated.

Outbreak suspension = visitation suspended following first positive until initial outbreak testing completed or because resident is in unit affected by outbreak.
