Ohio COVID-19 Vaccine Maintenance Program: for Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities

Ohio has been a leader, administering COVID-19 vaccine doses early, through the Federal Pharmacy Partnership for Long Term Care Program. To sustain the momentum of vaccinating our long-term care residents and staff, the Ohio COVID-19 Vaccine Maintenance Program was created.

Each month, nursing homes and assisted living facilities complete a survey indicating their vaccine needs for new hires, new residents, or those who recently decided that the vaccine is the right choice for them.
