17 Effective no later than January 1, 2024, the Department of
18 Medicaid shall adopt rules specifying that a Medicaid hospice
19 provider shall be reimbursed for room and board for a hospice

20 patient who is a resident of a nursing facility or an
21 intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual
22 disabilities at an additional per diem amount equal to one
23 hundred per cent of the rate established for the long-term care
24 facility for days when the patient receives routine home care or
25 continuous home care. As used in this section, "nursing
26 facility" has the same meaning as in section 5165.01 of the
27 Revised Code and "intermediate care facility for individuals
28 with intellectual disabilities" has the same meaning as in
29 section 5124.01 of the Revised Code."

33 **Sections 333.10 and 333.XX**

34 Increases GRF line item 651525, Medicaid Health Care
35 Services, by \$4,500,000 (\$1,600,000 state share) in FY 2024 and
36 \$8,900,000 (\$3,200,000 state share) in FY 2025. Requires the
37 department to adopt rules by January 1, 2024, to ensure that a
38 Medicaid hospice provider is reimbursed for room and board for a
39 hospice patient who is a resident of a nursing facility or
40 intermediate care facility when the patient receives home care.
