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## Mentorship Opportunities for Success for Life in the Work World

The ODBES and BAC teams are excited to offer students a unique opportunity to engage in mentorship sessions. These sessions are designed to help students learn about various careers, develop essential skills, and prepare students for their future in the workforce. We will host two mentorship cohort windows: one in February (Winter Session) and another in April (Spring Session). Each cohort will engage in three 30-minute mentoring meetings, with the first two taking place online (mentor joining a group by zoom) and the final session held in person at the school. ODBES will provide a 1-hour virtual mentorship onboarding with all companies. ODBES will provide an electronic background check for mentors at no cost.

### Mentorship Session Format

Each 30-minute mentoring session will involve one professional from your business working with a class of up to 8 students and a teacher. The sessions will be structured as follows:

#### 1. General Industry Information (10 minutes)

- Discuss the industry the mentor works in.
- Share future projections for job opportunities in this field.
- Explore the various roles available and the importance of the industry in the community.

#### 2. Essential Skills for Success (10 minutes)

- Identify key skills needed for success in the industry, such as:
  - Time management and staying on task
  - Producing high-quality work
  - Building positive relationships with colleagues and supervisors
  - Taking initiative and demonstrating pride in your work
  - Discuss how these skills can help you in your future career.

- Highlight internship opportunities and ways to gain experience in the field.
- Provide tips on how to connect with professionals and learn more about potential careers.
