




# **Meeting Goals**





# **Assessment Implementation Core Messaging**

What message will be delivered to all partners when discussing the implementation of a new assessment?

### **Overview**

DODD's main goal for Waiver Modernization is to sustain a waiver program that is innovative, flexible, and meets the needs of Ohioans with developmental disabilities and their families. **Switching to a well-known national assessment tool is an important part of this effort**.

### **New Assessment**

Launching a new national and standardized assessment tool, designed for people with I/DD across ages, will help create a full picture of individual strengths, while also identifying areas of need, **providing the necessary information to begin a strong, person-centered planning process.** The new tool will also make things easier by reducing the number of different assessments that individuals, families, and SSAs have to complete.

### **Acuity-Based Rates**

Ohio wants to make sure that **people can get services from providers** who understand their unique needs, and that providers are paid fairly for the care they give. By using a new, standardized assessment tool, Ohio will be able to create rates that are based on each person's level of need.
