<b>Annual Reviews/Renewals of Plans</b>	<p>It is expected, at the time of the annual review, that plans will be updated to reflect the new service of Basic Employment Skills Training. The plan should indicate the service authorized. The ISP should include person-centered outcomes that coincide with the service definition.</p> <p>Plans should be in compliance with new rule to ensure person-centered outcomes coincide with the new service definition.</p> <p>Individuals will remain in Vocational Habilitation either until July 1<sup>st</sup> of 2022 or until the start of their span, whichever comes later.</p>	<p>ALL PLANS SHOULD BE IN COMPLIANCE</p> <p>Vocational Habilitation should no longer appear in a plan or be authorized as a service.</p>
