Every person listed in this section is <u>not eligible</u> for Medicaid, **but Medicaid benefits will continue because of the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE).** This temporary Medicaid coverage will end after the month that the PHE ends.

Medicaid benefits may continue after the PHE ends if there is a change, but you need to tell us that there is a change so we can update your case information. If the reported change makes someone eligible for Medicaid, coverage for that person will not end after the month in which the PHE ends.

- Any change can be reported using the <u>Self Service</u> Portal (https://ssp.benefits.ohio.gov), by contacting your county JFS agency, or by calling the Ohio Medicaid Consumer Hotline at 1-800-324-8680.
- · We will make a new decision about Medicaid eligibility using the information you tell us.

If the people listed in this section are still not eligible at the end of the PHE, we will send you another notice of action to let you know that Medicaid benefits are ending and the date Medicaid will end. That notice will contain information about fair hearing rights and will explain how to request a hearing if you think these people are eligible for Medicaid. The people listed in this section will keep Medicaid coverage until you receive the notice from us saying that Medicaid will end.
